On Society

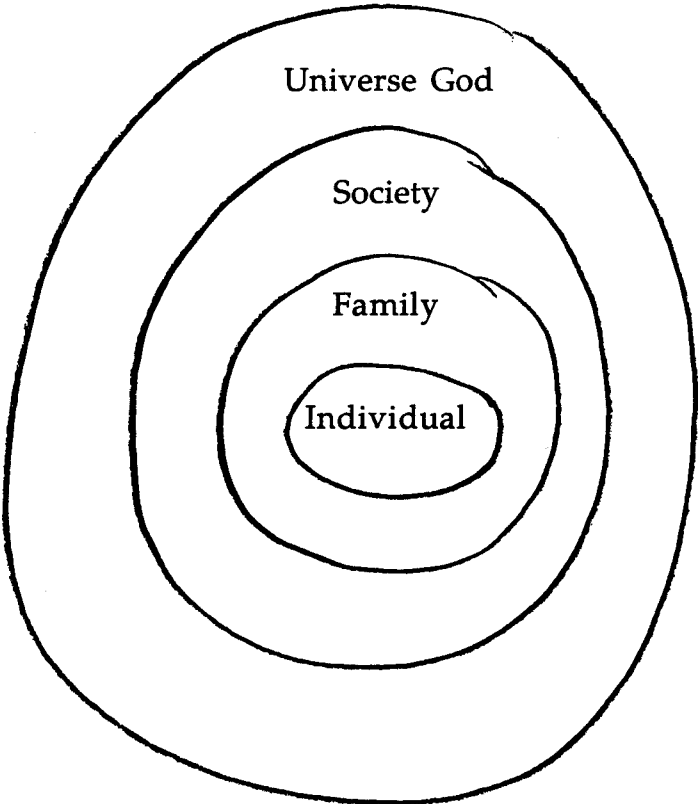
